March Filled with Light: Presentations from MWB Robert G. Davis and Bro. Logan Jeffers



BOOK REVIEW: HOW TO UNDERSTAND THE BIBLE BY MANLY P. HALL

"IN THE BEGINNING GOD CREATED THE HEAVENS AND THE EARTH." - GENESIS 1:1

FOR FREEMASONS, THE BIBLE HOLDS A UNIQUE AND SACRED PLACE, NOT JUST AS A RELIGIOUS TEXT, BUT AS ONE OF THE THREE GREAT LIGHTS OF FREEMASONRY. ALONG WITH THE SQUARE AND THE COMPASSES, THE BIBLE ILLUMINATES THE PATH TO MORAL AND SPIRITUAL ENLIGHTENMENT. AS SUCH, UNDERSTANDING THE BIBLE—ITS MESSAGES, ALLEGORIES, AND DEEPER MEANINGS—IS CENTRAL TO A MASON'S JOURNEY. MANLY P. HALL'S HOW TO UNDERSTAND THE BIBLE PROVIDES AN INTELLECTUAL AND METAPHYSICAL GUIDE FOR THOSE SEEKING TO UNLOCK THE BIBLE'S PROFOUND WISDOM, OFFERING READERS A DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF THIS SACRED BOOK THAT IS SO INTEGRAL TO THE MASONIC EXPERIENCE.

OVERVIEW OF THE BOOK

IN HOW TO UNDERSTAND THE BIBLE, HALL PROVIDES A HOLISTIC EXPLORATION OF THE BIBLE THAT MOVES BEYOND ITS LITERAL INTERPRETATIONS. HE PRESENTS THE BIBLE AS A TEXT WITH MULTIPLE LAYERS OF MEANING—HISTORICAL, ALLEGORICAL, AND SPIRITUAL—THAT CAN GUIDE THE INDIVIDUAL ON THEIR JOURNEY TO SELF-DISCOVERY AND ENLIGHTENMENT. HALL'S APPROACH RESONATES PARTICULARLY WITH MASONS, FOR WHOM THE BIBLE IS NOT JUST A MORAL GUIDE BUT A SPIRITUAL BEACON OF LIGHT. BY DELVING INTO ITS ESOTERIC TEACHINGS AND HIDDEN WISDOM, HALL SHOWS HOW THE BIBLE CAN BE UNDERSTOOD AS A KEY TO PERSONAL TRANSFORMATION AND UNDERSTANDING THE DIVINE.

THE BIBLE AS ONE OF THE THREE GREAT LIGHTS

FREEMASONRY TEACHES THAT THE BIBLE IS ONE OF THE THREE GREAT LIGHTS IN THE LODGE, THE OTHERS BEING THE SQUARE AND THE COMPASSES. THIS DESIGNATION UNDERSCORES THE BIBLE'S CENTRAL ROLE IN THE MORAL AND SPIRITUAL GUIDANCE OF A MASON. THE THREE GREAT LIGHTS SYMBOLIZE THE VALUES AND PRINCIPLES BY WHICH MASONS ARE EXPECTED TO LIVE: TRUTH, JUSTICE, AND VIRTUE. THE BIBLE, IN PARTICULAR, SERVES AS THE SPIRITUAL COMPASS THAT DIRECTS THE MASON TOWARD THESE IDEALS, PROVIDING THE FRAMEWORK WITHIN WHICH PERSONAL AND MORAL DEVELOPMENT TAKES PLACE.

HALL'S TREATMENT OF THE BIBLE EMPHASIZES ITS MULTIFACETED NATURE, WHICH IS ESPECIALLY RELEVANT FOR FREEMASONS WHO CONSIDER THE BIBLE AS A SOURCE OF BOTH PRACTICAL WISDOM AND SPIRITUAL ENLIGHTENMENT. AS HALL ILLUSTRATES, THE BIBLE'S MANY LAYERS OF MEANING GO FAR BEYOND SIMPLE HISTORY OR RELIGIOUS DOGMA, OFFERING UNIVERSAL PRINCIPLES THAT TRANSCEND TIME AND PLACE. THIS ALIGNS PERFECTLY WITH THE MASONIC JOURNEY, WHERE EACH STEP TAKEN IS GUIDED BY THE LIGHT OF WISDOM EMANATING FROM THE BIBLE.

UNDERSTANDING THE BIBLE IN A WORLD OF MANY VERSIONS

ONE OF THE BOOK'S KEY INSIGHTS IS THE IDEA THAT THE BIBLE IS MORE THAN JUST ONE VERSION OF A TEXT. TODAY, THERE ARE OVER 3,000 VERSIONS OF THE BIBLE IN EXISTENCE, WHICH CAN MAKE UNDERSTANDING THE ORIGINAL TEACHINGS A CHALLENGING TASK. HALL ACKNOWLEDGES THAT THESE MANY VERSIONS REFLECT DIFFERENT THEOLOGICAL, HISTORICAL, AND CULTURAL CONTEXTS, AND HE ENCOURAGES READERS TO APPROACH THE BIBLE WITH AN OPEN MIND, RECOGNIZING THE VARIETY OF INTERPRETATIONS AND TRANSLATIONS AVAILABLE.

FREEMASONS UNDERSTAND THE IMPORTANCE OF HAVING ACCESS TO THE BIBLE IN A VERSION THAT RESONATES WITH THEIR PERSONAL BELIEFS AND UNDERSTANDING. THIS IS PARTICULARLY IMPORTANT WHEN CONSIDERING THE BIBLE'S ROLE IN THE LODGE. MOST LODGES USE THE PROTESTANT KING JAMES VERSION OF THE BIBLE, WHICH CONSISTS OF 66 BOOKS. THIS VERSION IS USED AS THE STANDARD IN MANY MASONIC CEREMONIES AND IS TYPICALLY PLACED ON THE ALTAR DURING LODGE MEETINGS.

However, for Roman Catholic Masons, this poses a significant difference. The Roman Catholic Bible includes 73 books, with additional texts that are not present in the Protestant version. For Roman Catholic Masons, it might seem appropriate to consider Replacing the Protestant King James Bible on the altar with a version they hold sacred, such as the New American Bible, Revised Edition, which contains the full 73 books. This would ensure that the Bible being used in the Lodge aligns with their religious tradition and incorporates the full scope of texts they believe to be divinely inspired.

THE BIBLE AS AN ALLEGORICAL AND SPIRITUAL GUIDE

HALL'S EXAMINATION OF THE BIBLE ALSO INVITES READERS TO EXPLORE ITS ALLEGORICAL AND SPIRITUAL DIMENSIONS. HE ARGUES THAT THE BIBLE IS NOT JUST A HISTORICAL ACCOUNT BUT A SPIRITUAL GUIDEBOOK THAT REVEALS PROFOUND TRUTHS ABOUT THE HUMAN CONDITION AND THE NATURE OF GOD. HALL EMPHASIZES THAT MANY OF THE BIBLE'S STORIES—SUCH AS THOSE FOUND IN GENESIS—ARE SYMBOLIC REPRESENTATIONS OF DEEPER, METAPHYSICAL CONCEPTS. THE CREATION STORY, FOR INSTANCE, IS NOT ONLY ABOUT THE PHYSICAL ORIGINS OF THE WORLD BUT ALSO ABOUT THE SPIRITUAL EVOLUTION OF THE SOUL.

THIS ALLEGORICAL APPROACH ALIGNS WITH THE MASONIC TRADITION, WHICH FREQUENTLY EMPLOYS SYMBOLIC INTERPRETATION TO UNCOVER DEEPER TRUTHS. JUST AS THE SQUARE AND THE COMPASSES ARE SYMBOLS WITH MULTIPLE LAYERS OF MEANING, SO TOO IS THE BIBLE A TEXT THAT MUST BE UNDERSTOOD BEYOND ITS SURFACE LEVEL.

THE ESOTERIC TEACHINGS AND THEIR ROLE IN HUMAN EVOLUTION

HALL ALSO DELVES INTO THE ESOTERIC TEACHINGS OF THE BIBLE, WHICH ARE OFTEN HIDDEN BENEATH THE LITERAL NARRATIVE. HE DRAWS CONNECTIONS BETWEEN THE BIBLE AND OTHER MYSTICAL TRADITIONS, SUCH AS GNOSTICISM AND KABBALAH, SUGGESTING THAT THESE TRADITIONS SHARE COMMON WISDOM THAT CAN BE FOUND THROUGHOUT VARIOUS SACRED TEXTS. FOR FREEMASONS, WHO ARE OFTEN DRAWN TO THE STUDY OF ANCIENT WISDOM, HALL'S ANALYSIS OFFERS A DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF HOW THE BIBLE CONNECTS WITH OTHER SPIRITUAL TRADITIONS, FURTHER ENRICHING THE MASONIC EXPERIENCE.

FURTHERMORE, HALL SPEAKS OF THE BIBLE AS A TOOL FOR HUMAN EVOLUTION. JUST AS FREEMASONRY ENCOURAGES MEMBERS TO PROGRESS THROUGH DIFFERENT STAGES OF SELF-AWARENESS AND PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT, THE BIBLE SERVES AS A BLUEPRINT FOR THAT VERY EVOLUTION—GUIDING THE INDIVIDUAL FROM IGNORANCE TO ENLIGHTENMENT, FROM DARKNESS TO LIGHT.

How to Understand the Bible by Manly P. Hall is a thought-provoking and insightful work that offers Freemasons a deeper understanding of the Bible's significance in both a spiritual and Masonic context. Hall's approach resonates with Masons because it acknowledges the Bible's central role as one of the Three Great Lights, while also encouraging a broader, more symbolic interpretation of the text. Whether exploring the Bible's allegorical teachings, its esoteric wisdom, or its role in human spiritual evolution, Hall provides valuable insights that will help Masons understand the Bible as a key to moral, intellectual, and spiritual enlightenment.

For Roman Catholic Masons, in particular, Hall's discussion about the differences between the Protestant and Catholic versions of the Bible provides an opportunity to reflect on the Bible they hold sacred. Replacing the Protestant King James Bible with a Catholic version, such as the New American Bible, Revised Edition, might be a fitting choice to ensure that the text used in the Lodge aligns with their religious beliefs.

Heaven and Earth: The Masonic Square and Compasses in Light of Genesis 1:1

"IN THE BEGINNING GOD CREATED THE HEAVENS AND THE EARTH." - GENESIS 1:1

AT THE VERY HEART OF MASONIC SYMBOLISM LIES ONE OF THE MOST RECOGNIZABLE EMBLEMS IN THE WORLD: THE SQUARE AND COMPASSES. TO THE UNINITIATED, THESE ARE MERE TOOLS OF THE BUILDER'S CRAFT. BUT TO THE FREEMASON, THEY REPRESENT PROFOUND SPIRITUAL TRUTHS—TRUTHS THAT ECHO THE VERY FIRST WORDS OF THE HOLY SCRIPTURES. GENESIS 1:1 TELLS US PLAINLY AND POWERFULLY: GOD IS THE CREATOR OF BOTH REALMS —THE HEAVENS AND THE EARTH. LIKEWISE, THE SQUARE AND COMPASSES CAN BE UNDERSTOOD AS SYMBOLIC REFLECTIONS OF THESE TWO DIVINE DOMAINS.

THE SQUARE: THE REALM OF EARTH

THE SQUARE, WITH ITS RIGID RIGHT ANGLE, REPRESENTS EARTHLY ORDER, MORALITY, AND JUSTICE. IT TEACHES THE MASON TO "SQUARE HIS ACTIONS," TO LIVE UPRIGHTLY IN HIS DEALINGS WITH HIS FELLOW MAN. THE SQUARE IS THE INSTRUMENT OF THE STONEMASON, USED TO ENSURE THAT FOUNDATIONS ARE TRUE, LEVEL, AND JUST—A TOOL GROUNDED IN THE MATERIAL WORLD.

IN THIS WAY, THE SQUARE REPRESENTS EARTH: THE PLANE OF PHYSICAL REALITY, OF LABOR AND DUTY, OF COMMUNITY AND CONSTRUCTION. IT SPEAKS TO OUR OBLIGATION TO LIVE RIGHTLY WITHIN THE NATURAL ORDER, TO BUILD WISELY AND ETHICALLY UPON THE FIRM FOUNDATIONS GOD HAS GIVEN US. THE SQUARE REMINDS US THAT WHILE WE MAY DWELL IN A WORLD OF IMPERFECTION, WE ARE TO STRIVE FOR VIRTUE AND HARMONY IN ALL WE DO.

THE COMPASSES: THE REALM OF HEAVEN

IN CONTRAST, THE COMPASSES STRETCH OUTWARD IN ARCS, MARKING BOUNDARIES AND DRAWING CIRCLES. IN THE ANCIENT WORLD, THE CIRCLE WAS THE PERFECT FORM, WITHOUT BEGINNING OR END-A SYMBOL OF THE DIVINE, ETERNAL, AND INFINITE. THE COMPASSES THUS REPRESENT THE HEAVENS, THE SPIRITUAL REALM, THE UNSEEN ORDER THAT GOVERNS THE COSMOS.

MASONS ARE TAUGHT TO USE THE COMPASSES TO "CIRCUMSCRIBE OUR DESIRES," REMINDING US TO KEEP OUR PASSIONS AND ACTIONS WITHIN BOUNDS. BUT MORE THAN THAT, THE COMPASSES CALL US TO REACH UPWARD-TO SEEK THE DIVINE WILL, TO CONTEMPLATE THE CELESTIAL, AND TO ALIGN OUR LIVES NOT ONLY WITH EARTHLY JUSTICE BUT WITH SPIRITUAL WISDOM.

IN HARMONY: HEAVEN AND EARTH UNITED

THE SQUARE AND COMPASSES ARE OFTEN INTERLACED OR JOINED, ONE ABOVE THE OTHER. THIS UNION BEAUTIFULLY MIRRORS THE STRUCTURE OF GENESIS 1:1–"GOD CREATED THE HEAVENS AND THE EARTH." IT SUGGESTS THAT BOTH REALMS–SPIRITUAL AND MATERIAL–ARE ESSENTIAL, COMPLEMENTARY, AND DIVINELY ORDAINED.

FREEMASONRY TEACHES THAT A LIFE WELL-LIVED MUST BE BALANCED BETWEEN THESE TWO REALITIES. THE SQUARE KEEPS OUR FEET FIRMLY PLANTED ON SOLID GROUND, REMINDING US OF OUR DUTIES TO SOCIETY, FAMILY, AND OURSELVES. THE COMPASSES LIFT OUR EYES TO THE HEAVENS, CALLING US TO HIGHER TRUTHS, ETERNAL PRINCIPLES, AND THE GREAT ARCHITECT OF THE UNIVERSE. JUST AS GENESIS BEGINS WITH THE UNITY OF THE HEAVENS AND THE EARTH, THE MASON IS REMINDED THROUGH HIS WORKING TOOLS TO BRING TOGETHER THE SPIRITUAL AND THE PHYSICAL, THE IDEAL AND THE ACTUAL, THE DIVINE AND THE HUMAN. TO BE A MASON, THEN, IS TO LIVE AT THAT INTERSECTION—TO BUILD ON EARTH ACCORDING TO A HEAVENLY DESIGN.

THE SYMBOLISM OF THE SQUARE AND COMPASSES IS NOT ARBITRARY-IT IS COSMIC. AND ITS DEEPEST RESONANCE CAN BE HEARD IN THE VERY FIRST LINE OF SCRIPTURE. IN THE BEGINNING, GOD CREATED THE HEAVENS AND THE EARTH. IN OUR BEGINNINGS, AS MASONS AND AS MEN, WE ARE CALLED TO HONOR THAT SAME DUALITY: TO SQUARE OUR ACTIONS ON EARTH AND TO COMPASS OUR DESIRES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE HEAVENS. IN DOING SO, WE REFLECT THE DIVINE IMAGE IN WHICH WE WERE MADE AND FULFILL THE SACRED DUTY OF BUILDING NOT ONLY TEMPLES OF STONE, BUT TEMPLES OF CHARACTER AND LIGHT /G\
