
ZOOM CALL WITH THE GRAND MASTER ON SUNDAY, MAY 5 AT 6PM!







"SEA CAPTIONS OF ALL NATIONALITIES, DOCTORS, PLUMBERS, SAIL MAKERS, WINE MERCHANTS, BRICK LAYERS, STATIONERS, SURGEONS, AND APOTHECARIES, SHOE MAKERS, CARPENTERS AND BUILDERS". WHEN I FIRST JOINED MASONRY I HAD A LONGING TO BELONG TO SOMETHING GREATER THEN MYSELF. WHAT I FOUND WAS A BROTHERHOOD OF MEN ALL WALKING TOWARDS THE SAME GOAL, JUST FALLOWING DIFFERENT PATHS. THIS IS WHY WE WALK WITH PRIDE. NOT BECAUSE OF OUR WORLDLY ACCOMPLISHMENTS, BUT BECAUSE OF OUR SPIRITUAL PROGRESS.
